Approximate seed count: 46,000 to 57,000 S./oz. (1,600 to 2,000 S./g)

Plug Production Plug Tray Size

Best produced in 406-cell or larger plug trays.

Sowing

Use a well-drained, disease-free soilless medium with good aeration and water-holding capacity. Cover seed with vermiculite at sowing. Water well, but allow the soil to dry slightly between waterings.

Temperature

60 to 72°F (15 to 22°C).

Light

No supplemental lighting is required.

Fertilization

Stage 3: Alternate 20-10-20 and 14-0-14 at 50 ppm each week

Stage 4: Same as Stage 3, but increase to 100 ppm.

Growth Regulators

PGRs are not generally needed, although **Corona** Cherry Magic and **Valentine** dianthus are responsive to Bonzi and B-Nine. An application of Bonzi spray at 6 ppm in early Stage 3 will tone the plugs.

Growing On to Finish Container Size

Corona Cherry Magic and **Valentine** dianthus are suitable for production in any pack configuration up to a 4-in. (10-cm) pot. Can be grown pot tight.

Temperature

60 to 72°F (15 to 22°C).

Fertilization

After plants are established, apply a calcium-based fertilizer or 15-5-15 at 100 ppm, 1 to 2 times per week.

Growth Regulators

Corona Cherry Magic and Valentine dianthus are very responsive to growth regulators, like other dianthus. For example, an application of Bonzi spray at 20 ppm can be applied 2 weeks after transplanting and another application of Bonzi spray at 20 ppm may be required 10 to 14 days later. A tank mix of B-Nine at 5,000 ppm and Cycocel at 1,000 ppm spray can also be substituted for the Bonzi spray above for a gentler effect.

Crop Scheduling

Corona Cherry Magic
Sow to flower: 10 to 12 weeks

Valentine

Sow to flower – Spring: 13 to 14 weeks Sow to flower from August sowing: 11 to 12 weeks

Producing Valentine for Valentine's Day finishing, based on California production:

Sow: Week 44 (approximately October 28) Finished container size: 3-in. (7-cm) pot or packs First flower: Week 6 (approximately February 3) Greenhouse temperatures: 70°F (21°C) days, 55°F

(15 C) mgms

For outdoor production, add 3 to 4 weeks to crop time. Supplemental lighting may be required in lower light zones.

Cultural Tip

Use a powdery mildew preventative program. Pyrrole and Piperalin can cause phytotoxicity.
